FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQ)

1. What is expected of participants during this trip?

Each SYNC group/participant is expected to fully engage in all of the worship experiences and other opportunities throughout our time in Pigeon Forge. Each participant should plan to be a “team player” that gives 100%! A positive outlook, a cooperative spirit, a mature demeanor, and a sense of adventure are expected at all times. Come expecting God to do BIG things in your young adult ministry!

2. When is the expected arrival/departure time at SYNC?

Plan to arrive for registration in Pigeon Forge on February 1st, between 3:00 – 7:00 p.m. Slightly earlier arrivals may be accommodated, but the window above is best. Our registration table will be near the far-right entrance of the Ramsey Hotel – not the main entrance. We will meet you to assist your group once you arrive on the property. Participants must be checked out of their hotel rooms by 11:00 a.m. on Sunday, February 3rd. (Worship begins at 9:30 a.m., so it is best if your group checks out prior to the worship service.)

****SYNC lanyards will be provided at registration and must be worn by all participants to gain entrance to SYNC worship services and all other SYNC events.***

3. Where will we be staying?

Participants will be staying at the Ramsey Hotel, Pigeon Forge. This hotel's ideal location puts all of Pigeon Forge in easy reach. Guests can use US-441 to get to and from Pigeon Forge, Sevierville and Gatlinburg, TN. SYNC guests can visit the famous Dollywood theme park or have a rip-roaring time at the Stampede. The Titanic Museum offers a glimpse into the most famous nautical disaster of all time. If the outdoors is your passion, The Great Smoky Mountains National Park is nearby. All SYNC events will take place on property at the Ramsey.

4. What is the basic schedule?

Amazing worship experiences and fantastic speakers selected just for Young Adults will minister Friday and Saturday night and Sunday morning. Optional Saturday morning Break-Out Sessions with great presenter on topics of interest to college age students are always popular. Those interested can share in the Service Project at the Smoky Mountain Children's Home on Saturday, otherwise Saturday is a FREE DAY to explore Pigeon Forge, Gatlinburg, Sevierville!

5. How much money should participants bring?

The basic Participant Fee covers entrance to all three worship services, two free “after-party” events and a few other “surprises”. Participants will be responsible for meals and transportation. Of course, each group is responsible for any attractions they visit while in Pigeon Forge.



6. What should we do once we reach Pigeon Forge?

Once your group reaches the Ramsey Hotel at Pigeon Forge, follow the signs leading to the SYNC registration table. Do not check in at the hotel desk. There will be a SYNC staff member present to give you your group’s lanyards and room keys. (Groups should bring any donations of paper plates or plastic utensils for the Smoky Mountain Children’s Home, collected for the service project, to the registration table.) If any balance of accounts is still owed, it will be settled at this time. Once you have Check-In your group at the SYNC Hospitality Table, you may find your rooms and enjoy some free time until pre-service begins at 7:45 p.m.

7. What about the “After-Party” events?

SYNC participants are invited to attend two “After-Party” events. Friday night, immediately following the service, SYNC will meet at the nearby IHOP Restaurant in Pigeon Forge for fun, fellowship, and of course, FOOD! Saturday night, you are invited to enjoy great fun at the Pigeon Forge Community Center for pizza, basketball, volleyball, bowling and more! Both of these events are absolutely FREE for your group!
